I Stay Clean and Sober for My Family

It has been 11 years since I've been sober. I am now back on my feet and ready for a new life in Tennessee in the next month. This opportunity wouldn't have been possible 2 years ago if I hadn't arrived at the Mission. Before coming to the Mission, I had a family with a son and a wife. Despite government support, it was still very difficult to raise a family, so I turned to fast money by selling drugs. And at some point, I started to use them more than I was selling them. Everyone turned their backs on me. My wife took

their backs on me. My wife tool my son and left me alone. I thought drugs would fill the emptiness in me, but they made it worse. I decided to remove myself from drugs as I witnessed what happened to the people around me. To improve my life, I researched places that could help me recover and found the Mission.

Even though I knew nobody in Boston, I took a chance here. And I have never regretted my decision. Since coming to the Mission, my credit score has improved, I've gained a few pounds, and I've made

some pretty decent friends who are working together with me to transform their own lives. After saving up for the

Hi, I'm Joaquin, I'm doing better financially and studying to become an interpreter, thanks to the Mission's guidance. Before arriving at the Mission, I made a series of poor financial decisions that led to homelessness. At first, I owned a bakery with a partner. The bakery was doing well, so I spent most of my money on partying and drinking. Eventually, I lost my spot as a partner and my

home. Without a home, I secretly snuck into an apartment to stay for a year. However, the apartment owner reported me and not long after, I found myself at the Mission.
